Grace

The late pastor and Bible scholar Donald Barnhouse perhaps said it best: "Love that goes upward is worship; love that goes outward is affection; love that stoops is grace. "To show grace is to extend favor or kindness to one who doesn't deserve it and cares never to earn it. Receiving God's acceptance by grace always stands in sharp contrast to earning it on the basis of works. Every time the thought of grace appears, there is the idea of its being undeserved. In no way is the recipient getting what he or she deserves. Favor is being extended simply out of the goodness of the heart of the giver...

And now that Christ has come and died and thereby satisfied the Father's demands on sin, all we need to do is claim His grace by accepting the free gift of eternal life. Period. He smiles on us because of His Son's death and resurrection. It's grace, my friend, amazing. That is enough to give anybody a "Yes" face!

KIDS OF THE KINGDOM and KIDS WITH A MISSION


What does it take to be a volunteer for Kids of the Kingdom? Two things come to mind:



"⁵ 'Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink,^[a] or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? Matthew 6:25

In Matthew 6, Jesus spoke to people who were in deep need. Many of those who listened to Him were simple people who lacked basic necessities, such as food, clothing, and shelter. They also had the same emotional and spiritual needs we do— to be loved, respected, and accepted.

Like many of us, some of the people listening to Jesus were guilty of striving to meet their needs without seeking God's help, and they were frustrated, anxious, and filled with worry because of it. Jesus said to them, "Seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you" (Matthew 6:33)

How do we get beyond a spirit of fear, striving, and merely surviving to the point where we are thriving—with a spirit of total trust in the Lord? Jesus told us how: we must turn our minds away from acquiring earthly security and fulfillment and focus on God and His kingdom. We shift our priorities about what we think about, and everything else is added to us.

Jesus, I know I sometimes focus on the wrong goal. Show me how to seek You and Your kingdom first always. Amen


